He was notable and popular in school and college because of his good looks and hand come physique. He was educated in both western and Indian philosophy. He changed his name to Vivekananda at the suggestion of Mahraja Ajit Singh of Khetri.

Vivekanand became the disciple of Shri Ramakrishna Paramahansadev. He attended the world Parliament of Religions at Chicago, USA in 1983 and represented India. Swamiji also formed Ramakrishna Mission in 1987 and carried out charity work for the welfare of humanity. He wrote a book by the name of 'Songs of the Sannyasin'.

Vivekananda died very young, at the age of 39, in 1902.
